

# QUALIFICATIONS

1. The presenting author must be a registered Congress participant.
2. Completed researches should be original and were not published in any scientific or popular journal or magazine nor presented either orally or as a poster in any local, national or international scientific meeting (e.g., convention, conference, seminar).
3. All of the authors agreed to present the completed research through oral or poster during the 19th AAAP Animal Science Congress – 57th PSAS SSAC. Papers competing for the Undergraduate Thesis category must be presented by the thesis student.
4. Submission of abstract means that the completed research complied with the animal welfare and ethics and/or bioethics guidelines. A copy of IACUC and/or bioethics permit may be asked.
